
CAMBRIAN INTERNATIONAL ACADEMY

By providing these selected pages from our yearbook, we hope you will be able to get a glimpse at what Cambrian Academy is all about.












Here at Cambrian Academy, our headmaster, Mr.




YES, the Headmaster is also very involved with the students--coaching the motorsports team and teaching the stage band class.
